
Chapter 964 H.B. No. 4067

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the boundaries of the Zavala-Dimmit Counties Water

- 3 Improvement District No. 1.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. DEFINITION. In this Act, "district" means the
- 6 Zavala-Dimmit Counties Water Improvement District No. 1.
- 7 SECTION 2. EXTENSION OF BOUNDARIES. The district accepts
- 8 as a gift and the boundaries of the district are extended to include
- 9 all areas that, on the effective date of this Act, are within the
- 10 geographical boundaries of the Bermuda Reservoir located in Dimmit
- 11 County, including the Live Oak Slough Dam and the Bermuda Dam.
- 12 SECTION 3. FINDING OF BENEFIT. All of the land and other
- 13 property included within the boundaries of the district as extended
- 14 by this Act will be benefited by the works and projects that are to
- 15 be accomplished by the district under powers conferred by Section
- 16 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution. The district is created to
- 17 serve a public use and benefit.
- 18 SECTION 4. DISTRICT AUTHORITY. The district may contract
- 19 with any entity necessary to implement this Act.
- 20 SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect
- 21 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members
- 22 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas
- 23 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for
- immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
