

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the boundaries of the Zavala-Dimmit Counties Water
3 Improvement District No. 1.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. DEFINITION. In this Act, "district" means the
6 Zavala-Dimmit Counties Water Improvement District No. 1.

7 SECTION 2. EXTENSION OF BOUNDARIES. The district accepts
8 as a gift and the boundaries of the district are extended to include
9 all areas that, on the effective date of this Act, are within the
10 geographical boundaries of the Bermuda Reservoir located in Dimmit
11 County, including the Live Oak Slough Dam and the Bermuda Dam.

12 SECTION 3. FINDING OF BENEFIT. All of the land and other
13 property included within the boundaries of the district as extended
14 by this Act will be benefited by the works and projects that are to
15 be accomplished by the district under powers conferred by Section
16 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution. The district is created to
17 serve a public use and benefit.

18 SECTION 4. DISTRICT AUTHORITY. The district may contract
19 with any entity necessary to implement this Act.

20 SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect
21 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members
22 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas
23 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for
24 immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
