

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the name of the Brazos River Harbor Navigation District
3 of Brazoria County and the name of its governing body.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Chapter 55, Acts of the 40th Legislature, 1st
6 Called Session, 1927, is amended by adding Section 4e to read as
7 follows:

8 Sec. 4e. (a) The name of the Brazos River Harbor Navigation
9 District of Brazoria County is changed to "Port Freeport."

10 (b) The name of the governing body of the Brazos River
11 Harbor Navigation District is changed to the "Port Commission," and
12 the name of each member of the Port Commission is changed to "Port
13 Commissioner."

14 (c) A reference in law to the Brazos River Harbor Navigation
15 District of Brazoria County means Port Freeport.

16 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
20 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
