- 4 SECTION 1. Section 29.907(a), Education Code, is amended to

- 6 (a) To educate students about the sacrifices made for
- 7 freedom in the founding of this country and the values on which this
- 8 country was founded, the week in which <u>September 17</u> [November 11]
- 9 falls is designated as Celebrate Freedom Week in public schools.
- 10 For purposes of this subsection, Sunday is considered the first day
- 11 of the week.
- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2007-2008
- 13 school year.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
