

1 premises that are the subject of the suit, post in a conspicuous
2 place near the room rate information required to be posted under
3 Section 2155.001, Occupations Code, an operating toll-free
4 telephone number of a nationally recognized information and
5 referral hotline for victims of human trafficking.

6 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
7 to a suit filed on or after the effective date of this Act. A suit
8 filed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law
9 in effect immediately before that date, and that law is continued in
10 effect for that purpose.

11 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
15 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
