- 1 SECTION 4. Subsection (d), Section 2054.008, Insurance 2 Code, as effective April 1, 2007, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 (d) Except as provided by Subsection (e), a company 4 investigation file:
- 5 (1) is confidential [and not subject to required 6 disclosure under Chapter 552, Covernment Code]; and
- 7 (2) may be disclosed only:
  - (A) in a criminal proceeding;
    - (B) in a hearing conducted by the commission;
- 10 (C) on a judicial determination of good cause; or
- 11 (D) to a governmental agency, political subdivision, or regulatory body if the disclosure is necessary or
- 13 proper for the enforcement of a law of this state, another state, or
- 14 the United States.

- SECTION 5. Subsection (b), Section 2054.256, Insurance Code, as effective April 1, 2007, is amended to read as follows:
- 17 (b) The [Except as otherwise required or permitted by
  18 Chapter 552, Government Code, the] company may not provide to an
  19 insurance agent information obtained from another insurance agent.
- SECTION 6. Subsections (b) and (c), Section 2054.008,
- 21 Insurance Code, as effective April 1, 2007, are repealed.
- SECTION 7. The change in law made by the amendment of
- 23 Section 2054.008, Insurance Code, by this Act applies to

information maintained in investigation files of the Texas Mutual

- 25 Insurance Company without regard to the date the information is
- 26 collected, compiled, or developed or otherwise becomes part of the

SECTION 8. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
