4 Ford Ironman Arizona competition in Tempe on April 15, 2007; and

9 their endurance in three successive events, a 2.4-mile swim, a
10 112-mile bicycle ride, and a 26.2-mile marathon race, all of which

14 event that attracts many of the world's best athletes; and
