

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1           WHEREAS, Family and friends of George Oscar Fisher, Jr., of  
2 Paris were deeply saddened by his passing on December 3, 2006; and

3           WHEREAS, Born on October 12, 1916, in Cooper, a son of George  
4 Oscar and Addie Adeline Kerley Fisher, Mr. Fisher served in the  
5 United States Marine Corps during World War II and the Korean War,  
6 rising to the rank of staff sergeant; after the military, he  
7 attended Paris Junior College and was employed with the U.S. Postal  
8 Service for 30 years before retiring; and

9           WHEREAS, This valued resident of the Paris community was a  
10 longtime congregant of the Calvary United Methodist Church, which  
11 he served as a Sunday school teacher and as a member of the  
12 sanctuary building committee; he was also a licensed real estate  
13 agent, a former member of the Golden K Kiwanis Club, and a Mason;

15           WHEREAS, Mr. Fisher was a devoted husband to the former Mary  
16 Lorraine Ammons, whom he married on December 9, 1948; he leaves  
17 behind a loving family and a legacy of service to his country and  
18 his community that will be remembered for years to come; now,

21 hereby pay tribute to the life of George Oscar Fisher, Jr., and
