2 endeavors, and loving relationships, Myrtle Perry McDaniel of
3 Menard has accumulated a wealth of memories to treasure; and

4 WHEREAS, Born near the town of Crews on October 6, 1902,
5 "Muzzie" McDaniel spent her early years on the family farm in
6 Runnels County; she moved with her family to Abilene in 1915; a
7 member of the Abilene High School graduating class of 1921, she was
8 a cheerleader, and she was recognized by her fellow students as
9 "Senior Beauty," "Class Favorite," "Most Popular," and "Best All
10 Around"; and

11 WHEREAS, She married Boyd Joseph McDaniel in 1921 and, over
12 the 65 years they shared together, the couple lived in Big Spring,
13 Abilene, and Menard County, where they owned a farm for many years;
14 they raised two children together, and while her husband and her
15 daughter have since passed away, today Mrs. McDaniel enjoys the
16 company of her beloved son as well as five grandchildren, 10
17 great-grandchildren, four great-great-grandchildren, and many
18 longtime friends; and

19 WHEREAS, Muzzie McDaniel has experienced many important
20 periods of history, including the dust storms of West Texas and the
21 Great Depression, yet she has faced any obstacles put before her
22 with strength, grace, and determination; the energy and good health
23 possessed by this impressive woman is truly an inspiration for her
24 family and friends, who surely count themselves fortunate to share
