8	before Thanksgiving Day of each year is Texas Adoption Day to
9	celebrate and encourage adoption, adoptive families, and adoption
10	workers in Texas.
11	(b) Texas Adoption Day shall be regularly observed by
12	appropriate ceremonies and activities that encourage participation
13	in and raise awareness about the adoption process and that honor
14	adoptive families and adoption workers in Texas.
15	(c) The Department of Family and Protective Services shall
16	create a statewide awareness campaign to promote Texas Adoption Day
17	and shall coordinate ceremonies and activities held throughout the
18	state.
19	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
20	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
21	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
22	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
