8	SECTION 2. Subsection (a), Section 251.009, Transportation
9	Code, is amended to read as follows:
10	(a) The commissioners court of a county [with a population
11	of less than 60,000] may authorize the construction of cattle
12	guards on a county road of any class. A cattle guard authorized
13	under this section is not an obstruction of the road.
14	SECTION 3. Subchapter A, Chapter 143, Agriculture Code, is
15	amended by adding Section 143.003 to read as follows:
16	Sec. 143.003. CATTLE ON COUNTY ROAD WITH CATTLE GUARD.
17	Cattle on a county road are not considered to be running at large if
18	the county road:
19	(1) separates two tracts of land under common
20	ownership or lease; and
21	(2) contains a cattle guard constructed as authorized
22	under Section 251.009, Transportation Code, that serves as part of
23	the fencing of the two tracts.

SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
