

AN ACT

relating to the creation of the Waller County Municipal Utility District No. 1; providing authority to impose a tax and issue bonds; granting the power of eminent domain.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Subtitle F, Title 6, Special District Local Laws Code, is amended by adding Chapter 8205 to read as follows:

CHAPTER 8205. WALLER COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT

NO. 1

SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS

Sec. 8205.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:

(1) "Board" means the district's board of directors.

(2) "Director" means a board member.

(3) "District" means the Waller County Municipal Utility District No. 1.

Sec. 8205.002. NATURE OF DISTRICT. The district is a municipal utility district in Waller County created under and essential to accomplish the purposes of Section 52, Article III, and Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution.

Sec. 8205.003. CONFIRMATION ELECTION REQUIRED. If the creation of the district is not confirmed at a confirmation election held under Section 8205.024 before September 1, 2011:

(1) the district is dissolved September 1, 2011, except that the district shall:

- 1 (A) pay any debts incurred;
- 2 (B) transfer to Waller County any assets that
- 3 remain after the payment of debts; and
- 4 (C) maintain the organization of the district
- 5 until all debts are paid and remaining assets are transferred; and
- 6 (2) this chapter expires September 1, 2014.

7 Sec. 8205.004. INITIAL DISTRICT TERRITORY. (a) The

8 district is initially composed of the territory described by

9 Section 2 of the Act creating this chapter.

10 (b) The boundaries and field notes contained in Section 2 of

11 the Act creating this chapter form a closure. A mistake made in the

12 field notes or in copying the field notes in the legislative process

13 does not affect:

- 14 (1) the organization, existence, or validity of the
- 15 district;
- 16 (2) the right of the district to impose taxes;
- 17 (3) the validity of the district's bonds, notes, or
- 18 indebtedness; or
- 19 (4) the legality or operation of the district or the
- 20 board.

21 Sec. 8205.005. EFFECT OF CHAPTER ON BROOKSHIRE-KATY

22 DRAINAGE DISTRICT OF WALLER COUNTY. This chapter does not affect

23 the powers of the Brookshire-Katy Drainage District of Waller

24 County.

26 SUBCHAPTER A-1. TEMPORARY PROVISIONS

27 Sec. 8205.021. TEMPORARY DIRECTORS. (a) The temporary

1 board consists of:

- 2 (1) Natalie Birdwell;
- 3 (2) Patty Trussel;
- 4 (3) Herb Love;
- 5 (4) Tom Moran; and
- 6 (5) Melissa Krauser.

7 (b) If a temporary director fails to qualify for office, the
8 Texas Commission on Environmental Quality shall appoint a person to
9 fill the vacancy.

10 (c) Temporary directors serve until the earlier of:

- 11 (1) the date directors are elected under Section
- 12 8205.024; or
- 13 (2) the date this chapter expires under Section
- 14 8205.003.

15 Sec. 8205.022. ORGANIZATIONAL MEETING OF TEMPORARY
16 DIRECTORS. As soon as practicable after all the temporary
17 directors have qualified under Section 49.055, Water Code, the
18 temporary directors shall meet at a location in the district
19 agreeable to a majority of the directors. If a location cannot be
20 agreed upon, the directors shall meet at the Waller County
21 Courthouse. At the meeting, the temporary directors shall elect
22 officers from among the temporary directors and conduct any other
23 district business.

24 Sec. 8205.023. CONSENT OF MUNICIPALITY REQUIRED. The
25 temporary directors may not hold an election under Section 8205.024
26 until each municipality in whose corporate limits or
27 extraterritorial jurisdiction the district is located has adopted a

1 resolution consenting to the creation of the district.

2 Sec. 8205.024. CONFIRMATION AND INITIAL DIRECTORS'
3 ELECTION. The temporary directors shall hold an election to
4 confirm the creation of the district and to elect five directors as
5 provided by Section 49.102, Water Code.

6 Sec. 8205.025. INITIAL ELECTED DIRECTORS; TERMS. The
7 directors elected under Section 8205.024 shall draw lots to
8 determine which two shall serve until the first regularly scheduled
9 election of directors and which three shall serve until the second
10 regularly scheduled election of directors.

11 Sec. 8205.026. EXPIRATION OF SUBCHAPTER. This subchapter
12 expires September 1, 2014.

13 [Sections 8205.027-8205.050 reserved for expansion]

14 SUBCHAPTER B. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

15 Sec. 8205.051. GOVERNING BODY; TERMS. (a) The district is
16 governed by a board of five directors.

17 (b) Directors serve staggered four-year terms.

18 [Sections 8205.052-8205.100 reserved for expansion]

19 SUBCHAPTER C. POWERS AND DUTIES

20 Sec. 8205.101. MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT POWERS AND
21 DUTIES. The district has the powers and duties provided by the
22 general law of this state, including Chapters 49 and 54, Water Code,
23 applicable to municipal utility districts created under Section 59,
24 Article XVI, Texas Constitution.

25 Sec. 8205.102. ROAD PROJECTS. (a) The district may
26 construct, acquire, improve, maintain, or operate macadamized,
27 graveled, or paved roads or turnpikes, or improvements in aid of

1 those roads or turnpikes, inside the district.

2 (b) A road project must meet all applicable construction
3 standards, zoning and subdivision requirements, and regulations
4 of:

5 (1) each municipality in whose corporate limits or
6 extraterritorial jurisdiction the district is located; and

7 (2) each county in whose jurisdiction the district is
8 located.

9 (c) The district may not undertake a road project unless
10 each municipality in whose corporate limits or extraterritorial
11 jurisdiction the district is located consents by resolution.

12 Sec. 8205.103. DIVISION OF DISTRICT. (a) The district may
13 be divided into two new districts only if the district:

14 (1) has no outstanding bonded debt; and

15 (2) is not imposing ad valorem taxes.

16 (b) The division procedure is prescribed by Sections 53.030
17 through 53.041, Water Code.

18 (c) Any new district created by the division of the district
19 has all the powers and duties of the district.

20 (d) Any new district created by the division of the district
21 may not, at the time the new district is created, contain any land
22 outside the area described by Section 2 of the Act creating this
23 chapter.

24 Sec. 8205.104. COMPLIANCE WITH MUNICIPAL CONSENT
25 RESOLUTIONS. The district shall comply with all applicable
26 requirements of any resolution, adopted by the governing body of a
27 municipality, that consents to the creation of the district or to

1 the inclusion of land in the district.

3 SUBCHAPTER D. GENERAL FINANCIAL PROVISIONS

4 Sec. 8205.151. TAX TO REPAY BONDS. The district may impose
5 a tax to pay the principal of or interest on bonds or other
6 obligations issued under Section 8205.201.

8 SUBCHAPTER E. BONDS

9 Sec. 8205.201. AUTHORITY TO ISSUE BONDS AND OTHER
10 OBLIGATIONS. (a) The district may issue bonds or other obligations
11 as provided by Chapters 49 and 54, Water Code, to finance the
12 construction, maintenance, or operation of a project under Section
13 8205.101 or 8205.102.

14 (b) The district may not issue bonds or other obligations to
15 finance projects authorized by Section 8205.102 unless the issuance
16 is approved by a vote of a two-thirds majority of the district
17 voters voting at an election called for that purpose.

18 (c) Bonds or other obligations issued or incurred to finance
19 projects authorized by Section 8205.102 may not exceed one-fourth
20 of the assessed value of the real property in the district.

21 SECTION 2. The Waller County Municipal Utility District No.
22 1 includes all the territory contained in the following area:

12 "Kalkomey Surveying" set for a reentry corner to the herein
13 described tract, same being the northwest corner of said adjoining

15 THENCE South 01 degree 58 minutes 56 seconds East continuing
16 along said common line, at 228.10 feet pass the south line of said

13 recorded in Volume 0543, Page 906, Official Records, Waller County,
14 Texas, at 1,881.55 feet pass a $\frac{1}{2}$ inch iron pipe with cap marked
15 "Kalkomey Surveying" found on said line for the northwest corner of
16 said adjoining called 22.00 acre tract, same being the northeast
17 corner of the aforementioned adjoining called 20.00 acre tract
18 described in deed recorded in Volume 0540, Page 687, Official
19 Records, Waller County, Texas, and continuing for a total distance
20 of 3,371.67 feet (called 3,371.54 feet) to the Place of Beginning
21 and containing 1,445.765 acres of land, more or less.

22 SECTION 3. (a) The legal notice of the intention to
23 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this
24 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a
25 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,
26 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished
27 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,

1 Government Code.

2 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has
3 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
4 Environmental Quality.

5 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed
6 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the
7 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of
8 representatives within the required time.

9 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
10 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
11 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled
12 and accomplished.

13 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
