2 relating to the area served by certain municipal drainage utility 3 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 SECTION 1. Subdivision (8), Section 402.044, Local 6 Government Code, is amended to read as follows: 7 "Service area" means the municipal boundaries and 8 any other land areas outside the municipal boundaries which, as a result of topography or hydraulics, contribute overland flow into 9 10 the watersheds served by the drainage system of a municipality; provided, however, that in no event may a service area extend 11 12 farther than the boundaries of a municipality's 13 extraterritorial jurisdiction, nor, except as provided by Section 14 402.0451, may a service area of one municipality extend into the 15 boundaries of another municipality. The service area is to be 16 established in the ordinance establishing the drainage utility. Provided, that no municipality shall extend a service area outside 17 18 of its municipal boundaries except: 19 a municipality of more than 500,000 [400,000] 20 population located within 50 miles of an international border [in

- 4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
