7	is amended by adding Section 48.358 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 48.358. RETALIATION PROHIBITED. (a) A provider may
9	not retaliate against a person for filing a report or providing
10	information in good faith relating to the possible abuse, neglect,
11	or exploitation of an individual receiving services from the
12	provider or residing in a residence owned, operated, or controlled
13	by the provider in which services are provided.
14	(b) This section does not prohibit a provider from
15	terminating an employee for a reason other than retaliation.
16	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
17	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
18	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
19	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
20	Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
