

## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1           WHEREAS, After 30 years of service to the City of Irving,  
2 Steve McCullough is retiring from his position as city manager on  
3 September 30, 2005; and

4           WHEREAS, This noteworthy Texan first began his career with  
5 the city in June 1975 as an administrative assistant in the finance,  
6 department; three years later, he joined the city manager's office  
7 and was promoted to the position of deputy city manager in 1986; and

8           WHEREAS, In his role as city manager for the past 12 years,  
9 Mr. McCullough has initiated transportation improvement projects  
10 throughout the city and assisted in the development of a new  
11 comprehensive transportation plan, a light rail line from Las  
12 Colinas to DFW International Airport, and a water reuse contract  
13 with the Trinity River Authority; and

14           WHEREAS, Mr. McCullough also oversaw the construction of the  
15 Lake Chapman Water Supply Project and other new facilities and  
16 parks, including the Family Advocacy Center, a police substation,  
17 the Heritage Senior Center, Champion Trails, and the Valley View  
18 Municipal Complex; and

19           WHEREAS, His dedication to the needs of his community has  
20 been recognized by the *Dallas Morning News* and by the governor of  
21 Texas, who appointed him to the Texas Municipal Retirement System  
22 Board of Trustees, which he has served as chair; and

23           WHEREAS, Steve McCullough has helped lead Irving into a new  
24 century, and his efforts to promote the well-being of area

1 residents and his vision for a prosperous and productive future  
2 will continue to benefit countless Texans for years to come; now,  
3 therefore, be it

4           RESOLVED, That the 79th Legislature of the State of Texas,  
5 1st Called Session, hereby commend Steve McCullough for his  
6 exemplary service to the City of Irving and extend to him sincere  
7 best wishes in all his future endeavors; and, be it further

8           RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be,  
9 prepared for Mr. McCullough as an expression of high regard by the  
10 Texas House of Representatives and Senate.
