W. and Dolly Reel Brooks on May 8, 1910, 4 in Atlas, Mr. Brooks attended Paris High School and had the 5 distinction of being a member of the first graduating class of Paris 6 Junior College; he continued his education at East Texas State 7 Teachers College, now Texas A&M--Commerce, where he 8 bachelor's and master's degrees and completed postgraduate work in 9 school administration; and 10 WHEREAS, This outstanding Texan began a tenure in education 11 at Midway in 1933, and after teaching middle and high school for 12 four years, he was named principal of Minter School; in 1942, he 13 redirected his energies to the service of his country and worked at 14 Red River Arsenal for six years and at Camp Maxey in ammunition 15 surveillance for 19 months before returning to his career; he 16 retired in 1975 after serving as elementary school principal and 17 superintendent of schools in Honey Grove; and 18 WHEREAS, A member of Ramseur Baptist Church, Mr. Brooks was 19 the widower of the late Fannie Belle Brooks, with whom he enjoyed a 20 marriage of 63 years that was blessed with three sons; he was lucky 21 enough to find love a second time, and in 1995 he married Kathryn 22 23 Fry; and WHEREAS, Those fortunate to have known David Brooks will
