

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the training, examination, and seminar attendance  
3 requirements for applicants for or holders of licenses or  
4 registrations to perform certain activities pertaining to  
5 compressed natural gas or liquefied natural gas.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

7 SECTION 1. Sections 116.034(a), (c), and (h), Natural  
8 Resources Code, are amended to read as follows:

9 (a) The commission may [~~shall~~] adopt rules providing [~~the~~]  
10 training[~~, examination,~~] and seminar attendance requirements and  
11 shall adopt rules providing examination requirements for persons  
12 who are required or who wish to be licensed or registered under this  
13 chapter.

14 (c) Before a license or registration may be issued, the  
15 person to be licensed or registered must satisfactorily complete  
16 any [~~the~~] training, examinations, and seminars required by the  
17 commission.

18 (h) The commission may [~~shall~~] recognize, prepare, or  
19 administer continuing education programs for its licensees and  
20 registrants. A licensee or registrant must participate in the  
21 programs to the extent required by the commission to keep the  
22 person's license.

23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
