

<u>CHAPTER 201</u>
H.B. No. 1201

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the appointment of certain temporary insurance agents.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 4001.162, Insurance Code, as effective
5	April 1, 2005, is amended to read as follows:
6	Sec. 4001.162. RESTRICTION ON APPOINTMENT OF TEMPORARY
7	LICENSE HOLDERS. An agent, insurer, or health maintenance
8	organization may not appoint more than 500 [250] temporary license
9	holders during a calendar year.
10	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
11	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
12	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
13	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
14	Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
