1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to a limitation on the use of eminent domain by certain
- 3 conservation and reclamation districts.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 54, Water Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Section 54.209 to read as follows:
- Sec. 54.209. LIMITATION ON USE OF EMINENT DOMAIN. A
- 8 district may not exercise the power of eminent domain outside the
- 9 <u>district boundaries to acquire:</u>
- 10 (1) a site for a water treatment plant, water storage
- 11 facility, wastewater treatment plant, or wastewater disposal
- 12 plant;
- (2) a site for a park, swimming pool, or other
- 14 recreational facility except a trail;
- 15 (3) a site for a trail on real property designated as a
- homestead as defined by Section 41.002, Property Code; or
- 17 (4) an exclusive easement through a county regional
- 18 park.
- SECTION 2. Section 4.08, Chapter 1029, Acts of the 76th
- 20 Legislature, Regular Session, 1999, is amended by adding Subsection
- 21 (f) to read as follows:
- (f) Section 54.209, Water Code, does not apply to the
- 23 district.
- SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act does not

- 1 affect an eminent domain action initiated before the effective date
- of this Act. Such an action is governed by the law in effect when
- 3 the action was initiated, and the former law is continued in effect
- 4 for that purpose.
- 5 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
