

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the service area of the Ranger Junior College District.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Section 130.196, Education Code, is amended to  
5 read as follows:

6 Sec. 130.196. RANGER JUNIOR COLLEGE DISTRICT SERVICE  
7 AREA. The service area of the Ranger Junior College District  
8 includes the territory within:

9 (1) the part of the Ranger Independent School District  
10 that is located in Eastland County, except the area that is known as  
11 the old Bullock School Land; and

12 (2) ~~Young,~~ Comanche, Brown, ~~and~~ Erath, and Young  
13 counties, except for the part of the Graham Independent School  
14 District that is located in Young County.

15 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies  
16 beginning with the 2005 fall semester, except that during the  
17 2005-2006 academic year the Ranger Junior College District may  
18 continue to treat the area removed by this Act from the district's  
19 service area as if the area were still in the district's service  
20 area as necessary to avoid an unreasonable interruption of junior  
21 college services in the area.

22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
