- 5 SECTION 1. Section 42.043(b), Human Resources Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) The department shall require that each child at an
- 8 appropriate age have a test for tuberculosis and be immunized
- 9 against diphtheria, tetanus, poliomyelitis, mumps, rubella, [and]
- 10 rubeola, invasive pneumococcal disease, and hepatitis A and against
- 11 any other communicable disease as recommended by the [Texas]
- 12 Department of State Health Services. The immunization must be
- 13 effective on the date of first entry into the facility. However, a
- 14 child may be provisionally admitted if the required immunizations
- 15 have begun and are completed as rapidly as medically feasible.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
