

1 AN ACT
2 relating to the collection of certain administrative fees by a
3 community supervision and corrections department.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Article 103.003(b), Code of Criminal Procedure,
6 is amended to read as follows:

7 (b) A community supervision and corrections department
8 [~~serving a county with a population of 2.8 million or more~~] may
9 collect money payable under this title with the written approval of
10 the clerk of the court or fee officer, and may collect money payable
11 as otherwise provided by law.

12 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
16 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
