- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 112.035(b), (c), and (d), Local
- 6 Government Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) On <u>payment of the tax, the tax assessor-collector</u> 8 [presentation of the receipt, the county clerk] shall:
- o (presentation of the reactipe) the souncy often, shall:
- 9 $\underline{(1)}$ issue the person a license in the name of the
- state, the county, or both, according to the tax that the person
- 11 paid, that authorizes the person to engage in the occupation during
- 12 the period for which the tax is paid; and
- (2) pay into the treasury the amount of the tax
- 14 collected for the county.
- (c) The tax assessor-collector [county clerk] shall keep an
- 16 occupation tax account [for the tax assessor-collector]. [In the
- 17 occupation tax account, the clerk shall charge the tax
- 18 assessor-collector with each license issued for the county. The
- 19 clerk shall credit the officer with the officer's commissions and
- 20 with the amount that the officer pays into the treasury after the
- 21 officer files with the clerk the proper receipt from the county
- 22 treasurer.
- 23 (d) At the end of each month, the <u>tax assessor-collector</u>
- 24 [county clerk] shall make two reports. The tax assessor-collector

- 1 [clerk] shall mail the first report, relating to licenses issued on
- 2 taxes paid to the state, to the comptroller of public accounts. If
- 3 authorized by the comptroller, the report may be submitted
- 4 <u>electronically instead of by mail.</u> The tax assessor-collector
- 5 [clerk] shall file the second report, relating to licenses issued
- on taxes paid to the county, with a county officer designated by the
- 7 commissioners court [in the clerk's office]. Each report must
- 8 contain the information stated in the [tax assessor-collector's]
- 9 receipt for the tax and shall be dated and signed under the tax
- 10 <u>assessor-collector's [elerk's]</u> official seal.
- 11 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
