- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. (a) Section 504.3135, Transportation Code, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 504.3135. OPERATION IRAQI FREEDOM. The department
- 7 shall issue without charge specialty license plates for persons who
- 8 served in the United States armed forces and participated in
- 9 Operation Iraqi Freedom [on or after November 8, 2002, or on or
- 10 before May 1, 2003]. License plates issued under this section must
- include the words "Operation Iragi Freedom."
- 12 (b) The change in law made by this section applies only to a
- 13 registration period beginning on or after the effective date of
- 14 this Act.
- SECTION 2. Section 504.608, Transportation Code, is amended
- 16 to read as follows:
- 17 Sec. 504.608. MOTHERS AGAINST DRUNK DRIVING [TEXAS
- 18 COMMISSION ON ALCOHOL AND DRUG ABUSE | LICENSE PLATES. (a) The
- 19 department shall issue specialty license plates that include the
- 20 words "Mothers Against Drunk Driving [Boy Scouts of America]." The
- 21 department shall design the license plates in consultation with
- 22 Mothers Against Drunk Driving [the Boy Scouts of America].
- 23 (b) After deduction of the department's administrative
- 24 costs, the remainder of the fee for issuance of the license plates

- 1 shall be deposited to the credit of the general revenue fund and may
- 2 be appropriated only to the Texas Higher Education Coordinating
- 3 Board in making grants to benefit [Commission on Alcohol and Drug
- 4 Abuse for drug-abuse prevention and education programs sponsored
- 5 by Mothers Against Drunk Driving [provided by nonprofit
- 6 organizations that primarily serve children].
- 7 [(c) In selecting a program provider under Subsection (b),
- 8 it is the intent of the legislature that, to the extent permissible,
- 9 preference be given to a provider whose membership substantially
- 10 consists of persons who purchase the specialty license plates.]
- 11 SECTION 3. Subchapter G, Chapter 504, Transportation Code,
- is amended by adding Section 504.6545 to read as follows:
- Sec. 504.6545. BOY SCOUT LICENSE PLATES. (a) The
- 14 department shall issue specialty license plates that include the
- 15 words "Boy Scouts of America." The department shall design the
- 16 license plates in consultation with the Boy Scouts of America.
- 17 (b) After deduction of the department's administrative
- 18 costs, the remainder of the fee for issuance of the license plates
- 19 shall be deposited to the credit of the Boy Scout account in the
- 20 general revenue fund. Money in the account may be used only by the
- 21 Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board in making grants to
- 22 benefit educational projects sponsored by Boy Scout councils in
- 23 this state.
- 24 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
