- 5 SECTION 1. Section 201.091, Labor Code, is amended by

- 7 (f) For purposes of this subtitle, an individual who last
- 8 worked for a temporary help firm is not considered to be unemployed
- 9 until three business days have passed since the date the
- 10 <u>individual's last assignment ended.</u>
- SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 12 to eligibility for unemployment compensation benefits based on an
- 13 unemployment compensation claim that is filed with the Texas
- 14 Workforce Commission on or after the effective date of this Act. A
- 15 claim filed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the
- law in effect on the date the claim was filed, and the former law is
- 17 continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
