<u>CHAPTER 22</u> H.B. No. 1815

1 AN ACT

2 relating to term limitations for members of boards of certain

- 3 metropolitan rapid transit authorities.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 451.506(b) and (c), Transportation
- 6 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) An individual may not serve more than eight years on the
- 8 same board and may not be appointed to a term for which service to
- 9 the completion of the term would exceed this limitation. This
- 10 subsection applies only to a board of an authority:
- 11 (1) in which the principal municipality has a
- 12 population of more than 1.2 million or less than 300,000; or
- 13 (2) created before 1980 and in which the principal
- 14 municipality has a population of less than 1.2 million[+ or
- 15 [(3) confirmed before July 1, 1985, and in which the
- 16 principal municipality has a population of less than 750,000].
- 17 (c) An individual may serve two terms as presiding officer
- 18 under Section 451.502(e)(3), in addition to any service on the
- 19 board before being appointed under that subsection. This
- 20 subsection does not apply to an individual serving on the board of
- 21 an authority described by Subsection (b) or an authority confirmed
- 22 before July 1, 1985, and in which the principal municipality has a
- population of less than 750,000.
- 24 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
