
1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to inheritance rights of adopted adults.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 162.507(c), Family Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 (c) The adopted adult may not [retains the right to] inherit
- 7 from or through the adult's biological parent [parents]. A
- 8 [However, a] biological parent may not inherit from or through an
- 9 adopted adult.
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 40, Texas Probate Code, is amended to
- 11 read as follows:
- 12 Sec. 40. INHERITANCE BY AND FROM AN ADOPTED CHILD. For
- 13 purposes of inheritance under the laws of descent and distribution,
- 14 an adopted child shall be regarded as the child of the parent or
- 15 parents by adoption, such adopted child and its descendants
- 16 inheriting from and through the parent or parents by adoption and
- 17 their kin the same as if such child were the natural child of such
- 18 parent or parents by adoption, and such parent or parents by
- 19 adoption and their kin inheriting from and through such adopted
- 20 child the same as if such child were the natural child of such
- 21 parent or parents by adoption. The natural parent or parents of
- 22 such child and their kin shall not inherit from or through said
- child, but, except as provided by Section 162.507(c), Family Code,
- 24 the [said] child shall inherit from and through its natural parent

- 1 or parents. Nothing herein shall prevent any parent by adoption
- 2 from disposing of his property by will according to law. The
- 3 presence of this Section specifically relating to the rights of
- 4 adopted children shall in no way diminish the rights of such
- 5 children, under the laws of descent and distribution or otherwise,
- 6 which they acquire by virtue of their inclusion in the definition of
- 7 "child" which is contained in this Code.
- 8 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 9 the estate of a person who dies on or after the effective date of
- 10 this Act. An estate of a person who dies before the effective date
- 11 of this Act is covered by the law in effect on the date of the
- 12 person's death, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 13 purpose.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
