22	(4) <u>Department of State Health Services</u> [Texas School
23	for the Deaf;
24	[(5) Texas Commission for the Blind;

1	(6) Texas School for the Blind and Visually Impaired;
2	[(7) Texas Rehabilitation Commission]; and
3	(5) [(8)] any other agency or [that provides a
4	state-funded] program [primarily engaged in providing services to
5	persons with disabilities, as determined by the secretary of state
6	that primarily provides:
7	(A) public assistance; or
8	(B) services to persons with disabilities.
9	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
