- 6 SECTION 1. Section 156.002, Occupations Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 8 (c) A retired physician whose only practice is voluntary
- 9 medical care for a disaster relief organization is exempt from the
- 10 registration permit fee requirement.
- 11 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 12 to a registration permit fee that becomes due on or after the
- 13 effective date of this Act. A registration permit fee that becomes
- 14 due before that date is governed by the law in effect on the date the
- 15 fee became due, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 16 purpose.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
