2 relating to the disposition of state agency surplus or salvage

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 2175.001(1), Government Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (1) "Assistance organization" means:
- 8 (A) a nonprofit organization that provides
- 9 educational, health, or human services or assistance to homeless
- 10 individuals:
- 11 (B) a nonprofit food bank that solicits,
- 12 warehouses, and redistributes edible but unmarketable food to an
- 13 agency that feeds needy families and individuals;
- 14 (C) Texas Partners of the Americas, a registered
- agency with the Advisory Committee on Voluntary Foreign Aid, with
- 16 the approval of the Partners of the Alliance office of the Agency
- 17 for International Development;
- 18 (D) a group, including a faith-based group, that
- 19 enters into a financial or nonfinancial agreement with a health or
- 20 human services agency to provide services to that agency's clients;
- 21 (E) a local workforce development board created
- 22 under Section 2308.253;
- (F) a nonprofit organization approved by the
- 24 Supreme Court of Texas that provides free legal services for

- 1 low-income households in civil matters:
- 2 (G) the Texas Boll Weevil Eradication
- 3 Foundation, Inc., or an entity designated by the commissioner of
- 4 agriculture as the foundation's successor entity under Section
- 5 74.1011, Agriculture Code; [and]
- 6 (H) a nonprofit computer bank that solicits,
- 7 stores, refurbishes, and redistributes used computer equipment to
- 8 public school students and their families; and
- 9 (I) a nonprofit organization that provides
- 10 affordable housing.
- 11 SECTION 2. The heading to Subchapter E, Chapter 2175,
- 12 Government Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 13 SUBCHAPTER E. DESTRUCTION OR DONATION OF SURPLUS OR SALVAGE
- 14 PROPERTY
- SECTION 3. Section 2175.241, Government Code, is amended to
- 16 read as follows:
- 17 Sec. 2175.241. DESTRUCTION OR DONATION OF SURPLUS OR
- 18 SALVAGE PROPERTY. If the commission or a state agency cannot
- 19 otherwise sell or dispose of property in accordance with this
- 20 chapter or has determined that the property has no resale value, the
- 21 property may be:
- 22 <u>(1)</u> destroyed as worthless salvage; or
- 23 (2) donated to an assistance organization.
- SECTION 4. The heading to Section 2175.242, Government
- 25 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 2175.242. REMOVAL OF DESTROYED OR DONATED PROPERTY
- 27 FROM STATE PROPERTY ACCOUNTING RECORDS.

- SECTION 5. Section 2175.242(a), Government Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 (a) On destruction <u>or donation</u> of property under this 4 subchapter, the comptroller may remove the [destroyed] property
- 5 from the state property accounting records.
- SECTION 6. Section 2175.304, Government Code, is amended by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- (d) A university system or institution or agency of higher
 geducation may donate to an assistance organization any surplus or
 salvage property that:
- 11 (1) is not disposed of under Subsection (b); and
- 12 <u>(2)</u> has no resale value.

Act takes effect September 1, 2005.

SECTION 7. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
