

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the eligibility for a commercial establishment to have
3 its name displayed on a specific information logo sign.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 391.093, Transportation Code, is amended
6 by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (h) to read as
7 follows:

8 (a) A commercial establishment, to be eligible to have its
9 name displayed on a specific information logo sign, must provide
10 gas, food, lodging, [~~or~~] camping, or pharmacy services and be
11 located not more than three miles from an interchange on an eligible
12 highway. If no service participating or willing to participate in
13 the specific information logo sign program is located within three
14 miles of an interchange, the commission may grant permits for
15 commercial establishments located not farther than:

16 (1) six miles from the interchange;

17 (2) nine miles from the interchange if no service
18 participating or willing to participate in the program is located
19 within six miles from the interchange;

20 (3) 12 miles from the interchange if no service
21 participating or willing to participate in the program is located
22 within nine miles of the interchange; or

23 (4) 15 miles from the interchange if no service
24 participating or willing to participate in the program is located

1 within 12 miles of the interchange.

2 (h) An establishment that provides pharmacy services must
3 operate continuously for 24 hours each day and provide pharmacy
4 services for 24 hours each day.

5 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
