

1 AN ACT

2 relating to filing requirements for certain candidates for the
3 board of trustees of a junior college district.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 130.044, Education Code, is amended by
6 adding Subsection (g) to read as follows:

7 (g) The board of trustees of a district with a population
8 greater than one million may require that an application filed
9 under Subsection (d) be accompanied by a filing fee not to exceed
10 \$200 as determined by the board or, instead of the filing fee, a
11 petition signed by a number of registered voters of the district not
12 to exceed 200 as determined by the board.

13 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
