

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the composition of the Comal County Juvenile Board.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Section 152.0521(a), Human Resources Code, is
5 amended to read as follows:

6 (a) The Comal County Juvenile Board is composed of:

7 (1) the county judge;

8 (2) the [~~local administrative statutory county~~] judge
9 of each county court at law in the county;

10 (3) the judge of the 207th District Court;

11 (4) an additional judge of the district courts having
12 jurisdiction in Comal County, to be appointed biennially by the
13 local administrative district judge; and

14 (5) the criminal district attorney of Comal County.

15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
19 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
