4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 25.2481, Government Code, is amended to
6 read as follows:

7 Sec. 25.2481. WILLIAMSON COUNTY. Williamson County has
8 the following statutory county courts:

9 (1) County Court at Law No. 1 of Williamson County;

10 (2) County Court at Law No. 2 of Williamson County;

12 (3) County Court at Law No. 3 of Williamson County; and

13 (4) County Court at Law No. 4 of Williamson County.

14 SECTION 2. The County Court at Law No. 4 of Williamson
15 County is created on January 1, 2006.

16 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
