- 2 relating to a recreational sports fee at Stephen F. Austin State
- 3 University.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 54, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 54.5201 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 54.5201. RECREATIONAL SPORTS FEE; STEPHEN F. AUSTIN
- 8 STATE UNIVERSITY. (a) The board of regents of Stephen F. Austin
- 9 State University may charge each student enrolled at the university
- 10 <u>a recreational sports fee not to exceed \$120 per semester or summer</u>
- 11 session of longer than six weeks or \$60 per summer session of six
- 12 weeks or less. The fee may be used to purchase equipment for and to
- 13 construct, operate, and maintain recreational sports facilities
- 14 and programs.
- (b) The recreation fee authorized by this section may not be
- 16 increased more than 10 percent from one academic year to the next
- unless the increase has been approved by a majority vote of those
- 18 students participating in a general student election called for
- 19 that purpose. The fee may not exceed the amounts provided by
- 20 Subsection (a).
- 21 (c) The chief fiscal officer of the university shall collect
- 22 any student recreational sports fee imposed under this section and
- 23 shall deposit the money collected in an account to be known as the
- 24 <u>student recreational sports account.</u>

- 1 (d) A student recreational sports fee imposed under this
- 2 section is not counted in determining the maximum student services
- 3 fee that may be charged under Section 54.503.
- 4 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 5 to fees imposed for a semester or term that begins on or after the
- 6 effective date of this Act.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
