
<u>CHAPTER 183</u>
H.B. No. 614

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to foster care payments for certain children.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 264.101, Family Code, is amended by
- 5 adding Subsection (a-1) and amending Subsection (d) to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 (a-1) The department shall continue to pay the cost of
- 8 foster care for a child for whom the department provides care,
- 9 <u>including medical care</u>, until the later of:
- 10 (1) the date the child attains the age of 18; or
- 11 (2) the date the child graduates from high school or
- 12 ceases to be enrolled in a secondary school in a program leading
- 13 toward a high school diploma.
- 14 (d) The executive commissioner of the Health and Human
- 15 <u>Services Commission</u> [Board of Protective and Regulatory Services]
- 16 may adopt rules that establish criteria and guidelines for the
- 17 payment of foster care, including medical care, for a child and for
- 18 providing care for a child after the child becomes 18 years of age
- if the child is regularly attending [high school,] an institution
- of higher education  $[\tau]$  or a vocational or technical program.
- 21 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 22 to a child who is in foster care on or after the effective date of
- 23 this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
