- 8 times in a period of not more than 12 [six] months.
- 9 SECTION 2. For purposes of determining whether gang
- 10 activities are continuous or regular, the change in law made by this
- 11 Act applies only to a gang activity that occurs on or after the
- 12 effective date of this Act, or in the six-month period immediately
- 13 preceding the effective date of this Act. A gang activity that
- occurred more than six months before the effective date of this Act
- is covered by the law as it existed when the gang activity occurred,
- 16 and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
