1           WHEREAS, The Texas Round-Up is a statewide effort to  
2 encourage people of all fitness levels to incorporate daily  
3 physical activity and healthy choices into their lives; designed to  
4 educate and challenge its participants, the event ultimately  
5 celebrates the vigor and strength of all Texans; and

6           WHEREAS, This year's event is being held in Austin on April 29  
7 and 30, 2005, and includes numerous activities such as the  
8 Texas-style 10K, an activity training program, a health and fitness  
9 expo, and a post-race party with live music on the Capitol grounds;

11           WHEREAS, Sedentary lifestyles are contributing to an  
12 increasing number of health problems for our state's citizens, and  
13 this program helps motivate individuals to adopt and maintain  
14 healthier lifestyles; and

15           WHEREAS, Drawing entrants from throughout the state, the  
16 Texas Round-Up 10K is for every Texan, from seasoned athletes to  
17 recreational runners to occasional walkers, and it has a positive  
18 impact on the lives of all its participants; now, therefore, be it

19           RESOLVED, That the 79th Legislature of the State of Texas  
20 hereby designate the Texas Round-Up 10K as the Official 10K of  
21 Texas.
