HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Title 1 of the Texas Family Code was originally 2 enacted by Chapter 888, Acts of the 61st Legislature, Regular 3 Session, 1969; subsequently, Titles 2 and 3 were added by the 63rd Legislature in 1973, Title 4 was added by the 66th Legislature in 4 5 1979, and Title 5 was added by the 74th Legislature in 1995; and 6 WHEREAS, The codification of the Family Code and the 7 amendments thereto by successive legislatures have done much to 8 advance the interests of Texas families and children; and

WHEREAS, The 1973 enactments provided for suits affecting the parent-child relationship and introduced the terms "managing conservator, " "possessory conservator, " "possession, " and "access" as they relate to the family; and

WHEREAS, The legislature has declared it to be a public policy of this state, in cases of marital dissolution, to encourage parents to have frequent contact with their children, appropriate for the circumstances; and

WHEREAS, During the past 32 years, significant research in family dynamics has led to an emergence of new terms that are more commonly used to describe the relationship between parents in a dissolution of marriage, including "parenting plans" "parenting time" and other neutral terms; similarly, advances in field have rendered obsolete such terms as conservator" and "possessory conservator"; now, therefore, be it
