- 3 classroom, or they must receive the majority of their income from
- 4 musical endeavors; State Visual Artist nominees must work in two-
- or three-dimensional art mediums, must have been represented in at
- 6 least one one-person show, and must have an extensive history of
- 7 exhibiting in recognized museums and galleries; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Nominations are made by Texas citizens and reviewed
- 9 by the Texas Commission on the Arts, which develops a list of
- 10 finalists; the Texas Poet Laureate, State Musician, and State
- 11 Artist Committee, composed of members appointed by the governor,
- 12 lieutenant governor, and speaker of the house of representatives,
- 13 makes the final selections; and
- WHEREAS, The men and women who have been selected to hold
- 15 these distinguished posts for the next two years have contributed
- 16 magnificently to the vibrant cultural life of the Lone Star State,
- 17 and it is indeed a pleasure to recognize them at this time; now,
- 18 therefore, be it
- 19 RESOLVED, That the 79th Legislature of the State of Texas
- 20 hereby honor the 2005 and 2006 appointees to the positions of State
- 21 Poet Laureate, State Musician, State Two-Dimensional Artist, and
