



1 electronically receive, for each semester, the following  
2 information from institutions of higher education:

3 (1) the name of the institution;

4 (2) the name, identification number, and date of birth  
5 of each individual attending the institution and receiving benefits  
6 for the semester under Section 54.203;

7 (3) for each individual receiving benefits, the number  
8 of credit hours for which the individual received an exemption for  
9 the semester;

10 (4) for each individual receiving benefits at the  
11 institution during the semester, the total cumulative number of  
12 credit hours for which the individual has received an exemption at  
13 the institution; and

14 (5) any other information required by the board.

15 SECTION 3. Not later than October 1, 2005, the Texas Higher  
16 Education Coordinating Board shall develop the system required by  
17 Section 61.0516, Education Code, as added by this Act.

18 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
22 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.






