<u>CHAPTER 24</u> S.B. No. 177

AN ACT

2 relating to the composition of a board of adjustment in certain

- 3 municipalities.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subsections (a) and (b), Section 211.014, Local
- 6 Government Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) This section applies only to a municipality with a
- 8 population of 500,000 [1.18 million] or more.
- 9 (b) A board of adjustment shall consist of one or more
- 10 panels of at least five members each to be appointed for terms of
- 11 two years. If more than one panel of the board is appointed, the
- 12 board consists of the regular members of all of the panels. The
- 13 board may adopt rules for the assignment of appeals to a panel.
- 14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
