(a) All land and other property included in the district will 3 4 benefit from the improvements and services to be provided by the district under powers conferred by Section 52, Article III, and 5 6 Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution. 7 (b) The district is created to accomplish: 8 (1) the same purposes as a municipal utility district 9 as provided by Section 54.012, Water Code; and 10 the construction, acquisition, improvement, maintenance, or operation of macadamized, graveled, or paved roads 11 12 or turnpikes, or improvements in aid of those roads or turnpikes, to the extent authorized by Section 52, Article III, 13 14 Constitution. 15 Sec. 8142.005. - 22 municipality, a road project must meet all applicable construction
- 23 standards, zoning and subdivision requirements, and regulatory
- 24 ordinances of each county in which the district is located.
- Sec. 8142.105. COMPLIANCE WITH MUNICIPAL CONSENT
- 26 ORDINANCES OR RESOLUTIONS. Subject to the limitations of Section
- 27 54.016, Water Code, the district shall comply with all applicable

- 1 requirements of any ordinance or resolution adopted by the city
- 2 council of the City of Rosenberg that consents to the creation of
- 3 the district or to the inclusion of lands within the district.

17	projects authorized by Section 8142.103 may not exceed one-fourth
18	of the assessed value of the real property in the district.

20	the time bonds or other obligations payable wholly or partly from ad
21	valorem taxes are issued:
22	(1) the board shall impose a continuing direct annual
23	ad valorem tax, without limit as to rate or amount, for each year
24	that all or part of the bonds are outstanding; and
25	(2) the district annually shall impose an ad valorem

tax on all taxable property in the district in an amount sufficient

1 (A) pay the interest on the bonds or other obligations as the interest becomes due; 2 3 (B) create a sinking fund for the payment of the principal of the bonds or other obligations when due or the 4 redemption price at any earlier required redemption date; and 5 6 (C) pay the expenses of imposing the taxes. 7 Sec. 8142.203.
