

AN ACT

relating to the creation of an additional county court at law in Hidalgo County.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 25.1101, Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

(a) Hidalgo County has the following statutory county courts:

- (1) County Court at Law No. 1 of Hidalgo County;
- (2) County Court at Law No. 2 of Hidalgo County;
- (3) County Court at Law No. 4 of Hidalgo County; ~~and~~
- (4) County Court at Law No. 5 of Hidalgo County; and
- (5) County Court at Law No. 6 of Hidalgo County.

SECTION 2. Section 25.1102, Government Code, is amended by adding Subsection (b) to read as follows:

(b) The County Court at Law No. 6 of Hidalgo County shall give preference to family law cases and proceedings.

SECTION 3. The County Court at Law No. 6 of Hidalgo County is created on the effective date of this Act.

SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
