2	relating to the provision of employment services by the Texas
3	Workforce Commission to the families of military personnel
4	stationed in this state.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 302, Labor Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 302.0034 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 302.0034. EMPLOYMENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM FOR CERTAIN
9	FAMILIES OF MILITARY PERSONNEL. (a) The commission shall provide
10	employment assistance services, including job placement and other
11	employment-related services, to the spouses and dependents of
12	military personnel who are assigned to duty in this state.
13	(b) The commission shall provide the services described by
14	Subsection (a) in cooperation with the local workforce development
15	boards in areas of the state having a defense community, as that
16	term is defined by Section 481.501, Government Code.
17	(c) The commission may accept and apply for gifts, grants,
18	donations, and appropriations from public and private sources to
19	fund the commission's duties under this section. The commission
20	may use money from job training funds and other money appropriated
21	by the legislature to implement the requirements of this section.
22	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
23	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
