- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subsection (g), Section 53.002, Government Code,
- 6 is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (g) The judge of each district court in Tarrant County that
- 8 gives preference to criminal cases and the judge of each criminal
- 9 district court in Tarrant County may appoint two persons to serve as
- 10 bailiffs. Notwithstanding Section 53.071 or Article 19.36, Code of
- 11 Criminal Procedure, the [board of] district judges of the courts in
- 12 Tarrant County that give preference to criminal cases and the
- 13 criminal district courts in Tarrant County may appoint one bailiff
- 14 for each grand jury. [The total number of grand jury bailiffs shall
- 15 not exceed two.
- 16 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
