2 WHEREAS, The Legislature of the State of Texas is pleased to
3 recognize April as Jazz Appreciation Month and to honor Jim Cullum
4 as one of the outstanding advocates of jazz in Texas; and

5 WHEREAS, Initiated by the Smithsonian Institution's National
6 Museum of American History, Jazz Appreciation Month was established
7 to highlight the multicultural history of jazz, its important
8 influence on American culture, and the rich diversity of the music;

10 WHEREAS, Texas musicians have made many important
11 contributions to jazz throughout the years; *Riverwalk Jazz*, the
12 nationally broadcast public radio series from Jim Cullum's Landing
13 Jazz Club, is recognized by the Smithsonian Institution as an
14 important educational and cultural resource; and

15 WHEREAS, Jazz Appreciation Month is intended to encourage
16 people of all ages to participate in jazz; its aim is for people
17 everywhere to develop programs to explore, perpetuate, and honor
18 jazz as a national and world treasure; now, therefore, be it

19 RESOLVED, That the 79th Legislature of the State of Texas
20 hereby honor the contributions of Jim Cullum to jazz music and
21 recognize April as Jazz Appreciation Month; and, be it further

22 RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be prepared in
23 recognition of the importance of jazz to the cultural heritage of
24 our nation and the Lone Star State.
