

## AN ACT

1  
2 relating to appropriating the amounts deposited to the credit of  
3 the dry cleaning facility release fund created by House Bill No.  
4 1366, Acts of the 78th Legislature, Regular Session, 2003, to the  
5 Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

7 SECTION 1. (a) All amounts deposited during the state  
8 fiscal biennium beginning September 1, 2003, to the credit of the  
9 dry cleaning facility release fund created by Chapter 374, Health  
10 and Safety Code, as added by House Bill No. 1366, Acts of the 78th  
11 Legislature, Regular Session, 2003, are appropriated to the Texas  
12 Commission on Environmental Quality for the state fiscal biennium  
13 beginning September 1, 2003, for the purpose of administering  
14 Chapter 374, subject to the limitations prescribed by Chapter 374  
15 or otherwise prescribed by House Bill No. 1366.

16 (b) Any increase in state employee benefit costs incurred  
17 during the state fiscal biennium beginning September 1, 2003, in  
18 connection with administering Chapter 374, Health and Safety Code,  
19 as added by House Bill No. 1366, Acts of the 78th Legislature,  
20 Regular Session, 2003, shall be paid out of the appropriations made  
21 by Subsection (a) of this section and shall be allocated to the  
22 appropriate employee benefit appropriation items in accordance  
23 with applicable rules of the comptroller.

24 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003, if it

1 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each  
2 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.  
3 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary to take effect on  
4 that date, this Act takes effect November 1, 2003.


