3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 5, Insurance Code, is
5	amended by adding Article 5.35-2 to read as follows:
6	Art. 5.35-2. JEWELRY COVERAGE
7	Sec. 1. DEFINITION. In this article, "personal property
8	insurance" means insurance against damage to or loss of tangible
9	personal property, including coverage provided in a homeowners
10	policy, residential fire and allied lines policy, or farm and ranch
11	owners policy.
12	Sec. 2. APPLICABILITY. This article applies to each insurer
13	that provides personal property insurance in this state, including
14	a county mutual insurer, farm mutual insurer, Lloyd's plan, or
15	reciprocal or interinsurance exchange.
16	Sec. 3. ELECTION OF STATED VALUE OR ACTUAL REPLACEMENT OF
17	THE JEWELRY ITEM WITH ONE OF LIKE KIND AND QUALITY. An insurer that
18	provides personal property insurance coverage in this state for
19	jewelry will have the option to elect either to pay the stated value
20	or actual replacement of the jewelry item with one of like kind and
21	quality.
22	SECTION 2. (a) This Act takes effect September 1, 2003,
23	and applies only to an insurance policy that is delivered, issued
24	for delivery, or renewed on or after January 1, 2004. A policy that

- 1 is delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed before January 1,
- 2 2004, is governed by the law as it existed immediately before the
- 3 effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for
- 4 this purpose.
- 5 (b) Not later than December 31, 2003, the commissioner of
- 6 insurance shall, in accordance with Article 5.35, Insurance Code,
- 7 adopt any policy forms and endorsements necessary to implement
- 8 Article 5.35-2, Insurance Code, as added by this Act.
