- 5 SECTION 1. Section 43.1775(c), Government Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (c) At the request of the county attorney, the [The]
- 8 district attorney may assist the county attorney in the prosecution
- 9 of juvenile cases [represents the state in proceedings] under Title
- 10 3, Family Code.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 45.341, Government Code, is amended by
- 12 adding Subsections (d) and (e) to read as follows:
- 13 (d) The county attorney represents the state in proceedings
- 14 under Title 3, Family Code.
- (e) The county attorney represents the Wharton County
- 16 Drainage District.
- SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act regarding
- 18 proceedings under Title 3, Family Code, applies only to a
- 19 proceeding commenced on or after the effective date of this Act. A
- 20 proceeding commenced before the effective date of this Act is
- 21 governed by the law in effect at the time the proceeding was
- 22 commenced, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 23 purpose.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
